

Area 33 Recertification Process for AMIAS

The annual deadline required by WSO is July 1st for recertification of AMIAS (Al-Anon members involved in Alateen Service). The Area Alateen Coordinator (AAC) will receive a list of all certified AMIAS for Area 33 in March preceding the July 1st date. The AAC will contact all AMIAS on the list for completion of the following Area 33 requirement for recertification:

1. Complete and sign an AMIAS form as an acknowledgement of commitment to the Alateen program. (This form will be kept by the AAC in a locked file.)
2. A criminal check by the Nebraska Highway Patrol will be completed at the initial certification or as requested, if there are concerns, by another AMIAS or Al-Anon member.
3. A check for child abuse will be completed at the initial certification or as requested, if there are concerns, by another AMIAS or Al-Anon member.
4. Attend one training session per year which can be provided by AAC, DR, District Alateen Coordinator, or any other AMIAS that has received the training.
5. If an AMIAS does not desire to be recertified, or does not meet the minimum Area 33 Safety Requirements and is not recertified, a Status Change Form must be completed by the AAC and submitted to WSO at the time of recertification, which is the annual July 1st date.
6. If an AMIAS is not recertified, the AAC will shred the record within 30 days of the July 1st deadline.
